FAITH IN A LIE OR THE TRUTH



With pen in hand I am writing to tell it like it really is; and in doing that, to restore a right foundation in the understanding of God's people. May all who are tired of being robbed of what is theirs in Christ, stand up and listen. With ever-present truth we undertake with the Spirit of grace to expose an ancient lie. Know this day that *"no lie is of the truth."* It does not originate there. I John 2:21.

Teresa of Avila received a vision from the Lord sometime between 1515-1582. In the vision He said to her, "Ah, my daughter, they are few who love Me in truth. For if men loved Me, I should not hide My secrets from them. Do you really know what it is to love Me in truth? It is to admit that everything is a lie that is not pleasing to Me. Taken from her works.

Thus to hate the lie and refuse it and believe Him is to love the Lord. This reveals love's responsibility in presence of lies. To acknowledge everything that is not like Him, which is a lie and refrain from it, denounce it and declare the truth is love for Him. Now we understand better why we desire truth in all that it is, because it pleases Him, for in that truth we love Him. But what is truth? The truth is more than what we say that is from God that is true; it is what the Lord is in us and lived in us where we are. Truth is His nature, and then it is what He declares about Himself. In the nature aspect, did not Jesus say, "I am the truth?" We cannot love Him in what is not like Him. That is why we must go after holiness, for that is to love Him. "*Behold Thou desirest truth in the inward parts; and in the hidden part Thou shalt make me to know wisdom.*" *Psalms 51:6*. Every way of sin is a lie, from error in doctrine to the lifestyle of sin and all its deeds that are contrary to Him.

O! What consequences do lies bring to the human heart? No one can love God in sin! Do we hear that?

Indeed we live a lie or live the truth, there is no other. Then to reject what is not like Him and to live what He is by grace, I repeat, is to love Him. Let us love Him.

THE PROPHETIC WORD BEGINS

***T**here are only two things before my people, saith the Lord, truth and a lie; and it takes faith to believe either. My response to truth received is blessings, and to lies, judgment. As I appeal to faith for the reception of truth, and the doing of it, so does Satan appeal to faith that you*

may believe a lie, and do the lie. Do you know that whatever you believe, you become, and whatever you believe governs (controls) your life and destiny? I would speak these words unto you: when you have faith in a lie, your faith is misdirected, and has become unbelief in My truth. Therefore your adversary must appeal to your faith to produce unbelief towards Me.

In My Word I have given exhortation and warning: "believe not every spirit, but try (test, prove) the spirits, whether they are of God." 1 John 4:1. I have, therefore, made you responsible with faith. You are responsible for not believing a lie, and for believing the truth. Take heed to what you place your faith upon: be responsible to test and prove all things (you hear) before you release your faith. Remember unbelief requires faith in an untruth; because faith in an untruth is denial of the real. Now you know when (your) faith becomes unbelief.

The Lord desires you to realize that there is no such thing as non-belief; there is only unbelief. A man will believe, he can do nothing else. God made him a living being of faith. In Jer. 28:15 is seen this principle. See Jer. 29:31; Rom. 1:25. The issue is not non-belief; it never has been: it will always be; will you believe a lie or the truth?

You must understand, saith the Lord, the part of truth, which is mixed with a lie, is bait: it is used to trap you in the lies. Be aware, my people, of the deceptive use of a part truth and even how it is interpreted. There is nothing else but truth and lies; the voice, the message will be one or the other.

Before many in this hour is the grim figure of doubt. Doubt is the beginning of the breakdown of faith in one direction to faith in another direction. When gripped by doubt, you stand in two ways and have become double minded; your position is wavering and the dark cloud of uncertainty looms over you. Did I not say to Peter, wherefore (or why) did you doubt? Do you see, My children, doubt is a contention within yourselves; you are divided. You are one moment with the adversary and in the next with Me. Awake and realize he is trying to shift your position of faith to his voice and message. Doubts begin with questions and questions demand answers. You must be aware, if you have present truth, that you do not question My words. If you do, it is a sign that you are not fixed or settled (about it). Be assured, faith will make a move to the lie or to the truth sooner or later. Will you halt long between the two? No! Faith is activated by decision, and indecision for the truth means a soon transfer of faith to a lie. Stand up now, and ask, "Who am I going to believe?" You must make up your mind! This is the hour that you are in; and it is crucial, for it must be determined if you are for Me or against Me. Understand faith this day: it is loyal to whatever is embraced or chosen. You cannot believe Me and others (voices) at the same time, for I am Truth; a lie is my opposite.

When you see and perceive that a lie is an illusion, you will see the utter vanity and emptiness of it all. Psa. 31:6. Will you change your glory for that which is not real, but false? Will you stand, as I have said, and refuse to shift your faith to another? Remember the root of truth is love, and the root of lies is hate; of the two, which one will

you take in your heart? Yea, keep your heart with all diligence for out of it are the issues of life; but if you invite a lie, how can you keep it safe?

I have not left you alone. You are not without help. No! You are not at the mercy of an illusion. For in you is an anointing if you will heed Him, even the Spirit of Truth who will guide you into all truth. John 16:13; 1 John 2:21, 27.

The Lord has spoken and said the Spirit of Truth is in us. Now what we must understand is that our relationship with Him must be one of a deep and abiding fellowship. We must hear His voice and quickly obey. We cannot be mediocre in our response to Him and have His sensitivity to know the distinction between what is truth and what are lies.

Psalm 119:69 declare, *"The proud have forged a lie against me."* The Hebrew word for forge is to stick on as a patch. Fig. To impute falsely, forge or set up. A lie then has to be prefabricated, made up or forged. See Psalm 109:2; Job 13:4; Rev. 22:15. We must understand that a lie has a **purpose** and a **goal**. Herein is its **nature**: it is an illusion, it is not real nor is it true. Its goal is to trick, deceive, and distract. Furthermore its goal is to accomplish something and to attain something. God wants us to know to fight an illusion is to give it power. Why fight what is unreal and not true? What we must do is stand in faith and not believe it. We must not fight against a lie as something real or true but stand against it entering into our hearts. The Lord spoke to me one day, *"Don't fight paper tigers."* Then I understood, that is what a lie is. When an illusion is believed it becomes real to the mind. Then it is treated as real though it is a lie. As a truth can be taught, so can lies. Judges 16:10 says, *"A lie mocks."* Psalm 31:6 say, *"Every vain pursuit is a lie."* Jer. 7:8 say, *"Behold ye trust in lying words which cannot profit."* Read verses 9-10.

CHARACTER DETERMINES DESIRE, PURPOSE AND CONDUCT

Why does your adversary speak lies in your ears? These lies are the darts, which have pierced many. Only true and fixed faith in me can quench them. They are called fiery darts in Eph. 6:16.

Let the ears of your heart be attentive. Satan speaks lies because by nature he is a liar. Did I not say no truth can be found in him. John 8:44. He has the recognition before all as being the father of a lie. This is no secret; yet it is pushed aside and great consequences have been paid for it.

A lie declares character, and is born of character. In the traffic of lies, know that he has a charisma, and never to be underestimated. His lies have power and anointing and must be reckoned with. Wisdom will tell you that a lie is a temptation, but in it is a substance. If you yield to it, you get its substance. O! Here is your heartache, your downfall, your loss, and my Spirit grieves.

Heed my warning, he knows the best moment to plant the lying seeds, for did I not say that he is most subtle? Genesis 3:1.

I know him, saith the Lord; he lies about everything and all the time. Yea, without exception, without change. He is faithful to lies, as I am to declaring truth, for I can't be untrue.

Ask me to protect you in your weak moments, to change your shallow faith, and deliver you from your hurts, disappointments and carnal reasoning's; because these moments are his seed planting time; even your pride is fertile ground. In this hour he will lie about My doctrine, My name, My ways, My faithfulness, My love, My purpose. He will lie to you, about you, and about others to you. In these days he has lied about the victory of My beloved Son, but surely I will deal with it all, saith God.

Always, I say always know that the purpose or intent of a lie is told in accordance with the character of the one voicing it. Hate must present a lie. Do you understand? For the purpose is to harm, destroy, tear down, rob, divide, enslave and ruin. O! In the character of a liar is found all manner of deceptions, cover up, rebellion and hate. Have I not said Love and truth are in agreement and are one? My people know not that their adversary is a liar, for they have rather believed him than Me, though I have long said he was. Now see that hate and lies are in agreement and are one. So is it that lies are in agreement with every characteristic of evil; for where you find evil you will surely see some form of a lie.

We all must face the facts that a lie is spoken, propagated and perpetuated for the sole purpose of preventing the acceptance of truth; simple isn't it? Why so much attack upon the truth? Satan, evil spirits, and man's sin nature know that when truth is BELIEVED, it is the end of their reign of

darkness, deception and bondage over the mind of God's people. It is also the end of their reign over those who are not yet God's children.

What is your adversary really after? Only one thing, not many. He is after the FRUIT of God coming forth in the earth. John 15: 1-8. Verse eight says, "Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples." See James 5:7-8.

He seeks to prevent it from beginning, developing and coming to maturity. (Perfected) Luke 8:14-15. Do you see that he will abort it with great force of evil workings? It is God's purpose to form the nature of Christ in you, which is fruit. Galatians 4:19; Romans 8:28-29. This fruit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering (forbearance), gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance (self-control). Galatians 5:22-23. Fruit is divine nature, the very essence of what God is; and He is after sons that are in the image of the first born (Jesus). The one aim of all temptation and lies, which are attacks upon us, is to prevent the divine nature from being formed in our inner man. Consider what the Lord desires.

Yea, I say unto you, my people, have I not given unto you all things that pertain unto life and godliness? Why don't you believe all provision is there? Are My promises without substance and truth? I speak a word to My house this day, where is their determination, yea, as you would say it, the grit to lay hold of My grace, for the fullness of Me (fruit) in you? Have you no backbone, no stamina to stand up to one who would steal your birthright? Do you love yourself more than Me? If you do, you will not fight; for you won't pay the price for My gold. (Gold is divine nature.)

Fruit bearing demands that I cleanse you, but will you stay in the purification and submit? Yes, it is painful, but the fruit is everlasting. I have a people who give in to

the spirit of laziness and procrastination, which speaks lies in their ears. I know why, saith the Lord; they spare their flesh, for their love of holiness is weak. Some do not even know the value of that for which they are to stand. .

To those who are diligent, I will give everything, saith God; yes all! Surely I will reward the faithful with glory. Look and listen to the way your adversary seeks to kill your fruit. He lies in wait seeking whom he may devour. How? By destroying your faith in Me or by locking it up. Yea, he knows in order for truth to bloom and come to fruit in you; faith is required. See My Word and take heed. 2 Peter 1:1-12. Be alert, vigilant, for surely he will redirect your faith to his lies if you sleep, procrastinate or believe his falsehood.

Oh! My people how long I have waited for a people to oppose him, and show that their worship of Me is indeed genuine; yea, that I am who I say I am. You say, I am trustworthy, you say, I am honest; will you position yourself in that truth and prove it so by your stand? In this you will honor and glorify me. I have been much dishonored by My children believing lies.

Do you realize how I feel when you believe your adversary rather than Me? Surely he is after changing your mind; but I will ask again: was your mind and heart settled about Me to begin with? A lie my children, will make you a prisoner; it will indeed confine you to a dark place, away from Me, who is your Light. O! For someone who will know Me; that I cannot lie, even one who is truth, and has and will speak truth. In My love, My work has been to rescue from a lie and its damage. If you

choose to believe a lie, then you bind My hands towards you. Only believe, trust and obey! The first thing in obedience is to obey My voice, which says, believe My Word. Then to believe is to obey, to disbelieve is to disobey. Will you listen? A redirected faith to a lie is unbelief, which is disobedience. Listen and learn, and come out from the untruth and find rest unto your souls, My beloved ones.

◆ Here is insight to fight a good fight. To an enlightened warrior of faith in the truth, a lie presented becomes evidence that the truth is real.

Example: There are times when Satan works diligently to demote God to a non-reality, declaring that he isn't real. In these moments wisdom speaks; she says, why does he work so hard, so long and persistently at voicing that God isn't real; if indeed He isn't? Why does he concern himself with me putting faith in God who is non-existent? This is no threat to him. In fact he creates false gods for men to believe, which best suits his purpose.

Why? So they will never know the true and living God and His Son Jesus Christ, which is eternal life. John 17:3.

Remember, my children, your adversary never opposes the unreal, nor vanity or wickedness; yea, only the virtue and the genuineness of Me. You see he believes that I Am, for he knows My restraining hand and My anointed plan. How well he is aware that he has but a short time. See My beloved ones, his time is running out in this age. If you only knew, saith the Lord, what the devil really feels about the fulfillment of My Word concerning him. He is full of anger, but not confident, and has no hope. Revelation 20:10; Matthew 25:41.

Wisdom speaks and says that Satan's temptation and the flesh is always to **something** and **from something**; just as salvation is from sin unto holiness. Temptation seeks to remove one from righteousness to sin. Therefore why tempt someone unto evil if righteousness is unreal and of no value? Why lie about the truth, if the truth is the same as a lie? Wisdom asks another question. What gives temptation existence? **It is its opposite.** Only when good is a reality can there be temptation to depart from it. Therefore, temptation reveals the supreme reality of the pure character of God in all truth.

Lets face it; temptation only proves our incompleteness. Yielding to it proves our weakness, and overcoming it proves God's grace or ability and our loyalty. Weakness is not sin; it is our state of inability. God said to Paul in II Cor. 12:9, "*My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness.*" Now Paul says something about weakness: "*Most gladly rather will I glory (boast) in my infirmities (weakness) that the power of Christ may rest upon me.*" He furthermore said in verse 10, "*Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities (weakness).*" Isn't it plain to see that weakness is not sin, for he boasted in it and took pleasure in it? Have we learned to do such? So he said, "*When I am weak then I am strong; for the Lord's strength is made perfect in my weakness.*" ***Temptation is a test. No man can stand before God unproven.*** It must be seen what is in him. It reveals where our desires are, the measure of our obedience and our determination to walk in the ancient paths of righteousness. We have only looked at the **negative side** of temptation, which is an enticement to sin. Indeed I Cor. 10:13 tell us, that temptation must be accepted as a part of human experience. We must also look at temptation from the **positive side**, which is the way God views it. Temptation, then, from this view is an occasion to affirm my love and commitment to the Lord. It is an occasion for obedience and loyalty. It is an occasion for the manifestation of Christ in my life. Furthermore temptations are times for an adventure of faith. To see temptation from this standpoint is a tremendous asset.

“Because My people have forgotten Me, they have burned incense to vanity, and they have caused them to stumble in their ways from the ancient paths, to walk in paths, in a way not cast up;” Jeremiah 18:15.

Temptation is always an appeal to our lust, which is our desire. Our flesh has an attraction to evil and must be resisted. Sometimes we know when a lie is spoken to us, but when our flesh desires something, we choose to deceive ourselves by believing a lie. Why? Because we desire to have what is illegal. James 1:13-16. Make a decisive choice to remain in that which you have heard of the Lord in the beginning. Lies do not live on your cross, neither does your flesh. *“Jesus saith unto them all, if any man will come after Me, let him deny himself; and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.” Luke 9:23.* A temptation, and a lie, are always against you with respect to denying yourself. Since self-gratification is the very essence of the nature of evil, it is therefore plain to see why he opposes the cross. The enemy knows quite well that when you deny yourself, it will release the Christ nature to come forth and express itself in you. The truth of holiness is real; prove it so by divinely empowered obedience. The Lord’s summons to holiness is not in the absence of evil, but rather in the midst of it, in you and around you. Paul said, *“I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me.” Romans 7:21.*

Your adversary is skillful in forming lies and temptations and in the presentation of them. Job gives us an insight about lies. He spoke to his so-called friends and said, *“Ye are forgers of lies, ye are physicians of no value. O that you would altogether hold your peace! and it should be your wisdom.”* Job 13:4-5. This word “forge” means to give form or shape to something; to devise. What we learn from this is that a lie has to be developed or made. The reason why it has to be forged is because the truth already exists and never was made or forged, because God is truth. In that the truth has always existed, a lie is forged to contradict it. Do you now understand that a lie is made up to contradict what always was and cannot be altered? The whole root reason of a lie, to say it in other words, is to cause a people to err. Err from what? From what already

exists in God - the good of truth. So we understand that a lie is against the truth. If there is no truth, there is not anything to lie about. Once again I ask you the question, "What does a lie substantiate?" The truth! ***"And there shall in no wise enter into it (New Jerusalem) any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, nor maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life."*** Rev. 21:21-27. Note also, Rev. 22:15. The enemy knows how to appeal to your flesh in forging the necessary lie in order to change your mind, which causes you to err. Your responsibility is not to allow him to deceive you. He will present a lie of compromise, cloaking and camouflaging his every move. ***"Every man is tempted when he is drawn away of his own lust (desire)."*** James 1:14.

Be ye therefore wise my people. I say unto you let him not take away the eyes of your understanding nor the wisdom I have given to save you from him. Consider the extreme aspect of blindness and heed well. In this day many are calling evil good and good evil, such is radical confusion, and a mind void of discernment. It is no different saith the Lord, to call truth a lie and a lie the truth. When thou believest a lie do you know what you do? Yea, you call your Father a liar.

Are you valiant for truth? Then you must fight the good fight of faith. 1 Timothy 6:11-12. Indeed my children, there is no easy believeism. When you first believed it was only the beginning. So you believe My words are truth; now arise and believe for the substance of the truth, yea, for My character to be formed in you. In this you must be steadfast, for surely your enemy is diligent to oppose you.

LIES: THE ADVERSARY'S STRATEGY

Here are some lies, **which** the adversary has consistently presented and many have been snared thereby. Have you ever heard any of these? Do not let them enter through the ear of your heart. Brethren, do not put your faith in them. When you hear them, think the Word of God, speak the Word of God, focus on the Lord Jesus, and hold fast your position in the truth. No one can fight your battle for you, only you. Of a truth, others may help you, undergird you, encourage you, pray for you, and battle with you, but you must win the victory. **The following is the voice of Satan the world and flesh, do not believe them, but I ask are you?**

The lies.

1. **You are tired of battling against sin and temptation: give up, relax and let go; it isn't worth it. It isn't worth paying the price.**

Jesus paid the price for you to know the worth of God, the value of a righteous life and to worship, which is a response to his worth. He opened your eyes so you could see his glory that is his nature, which is his worth. Will you now believe a lie that says it is not worth it to live his life in the midst of opposition? Many a martyr laid their lives down in love saying it was. *They love not their lives even unto death.* Rev. 12:11. They said what Jesus did on the cross has exceeding much value. Would you prove your adversary a liar by laying down your life for the Lord's life and the Lord's way? To be satisfied with God is to know you have the supreme worth. Don't join Satan, the world and your flesh by agreeing with them that the life of God is not worth paying the price to live it. True

love only loves what is of worth. Do you really love Him? I repeat your worship is your estimate of God's value proven in your faithfulness and obedience no matter what you must face. His grace given to you to do so reveals that He is telling you it is. Not to pay the price is not to understand and not to love and will prove you are unworthy of the kingdom. Some how your sense is being worked on. "*Any one who puts his hands to the plough and looks back is not fit for the kingdom.*". Lk. 9:62.

2. **You don't have any faith and never will.** This is spoken to produce fear.
3. **You aren't good enough for God to bring you to maturity in Christ.** Then why did Jesus die for you when you were in your sins?
4. **God's Word doesn't work; you are fooling yourself.**
5. **God really doesn't love you.**
6. **Others are more favored than you. You are of no value.**
7. **You've done too many things, yes, sinned too much, for God to forgive you.** But God says, He is never tired of forgiving.
8. **You will never make it. Yes, it's too late.**
9. **You don't have enough faith to receive what God has for you.**
10. **I, (Satan), have you in my power now and you will never be able to be free from it.** This is spoken to produce fear, and where fear is, there is no faith exercised in the truth.
11. **You are a failure, and of no worth, you never do anything right.** This lie produces inactivity and no spiritual work in God's service.

12. You don't have what it takes for this spiritual walk; others do, but not you.
13. God has totally rejected you; there is no hope for you.
14. God has failed you, so get angry and leave Him. You'll have more peace if you depart this way of life.
15. You had less trouble in the world than following God. Get out of all that and you will have rest. He has let you down any way.
16. The Bible is full of mistakes and therefore not all true.
17. God is only a figment of your imagination. He is not real, and as for Jesus, He was only another man.
18. Take the easy way; you don't have to be responsible. Bearing your cross takes the joy out of life. This way is hard and demanding.
19. You have a right to feel hurt, and not forgive, look at what they have done to you.
20. All preachers and churches are a bunch of hypocrites.
21. You are too busy to pray and read the Word of God. You can make it without all of that.
22. You have prayed and prayed, and it doesn't work so why don't you quit praying? You don't feel his presence anyway. When you don't feel His presence and sin is not the factor, then sow to His presence and you shall reap his presence in due time. Praise the Lord!
23. Don't confess your faults or sins to anyone. You will look weak. After all, you want to look good don't you?

24. **You have married the wrong person. Get out of it.**
Here you must see things through the eyes of God and not yours
25. **Look how well you do things. Others are not as good as you.**
This is spoken to produce vanity and pride if you listen to it.
26. **You no longer need the Bible. Go directly to God.**
27. **You are now perfect and do not sin.**
28. **Praise is just emotionalism. It is not for you.**
29. **The devil no longer exists. You are in a new day.**
30. **God is finished with the local church. You don't need it anymore.**
31. **It doesn't hurt to lie just a little. After all, you have to protect yourself.**
32. **You are too old to serve God, just relax let the younger ones do it.**
33. **You aren't called to the ministry. You are just hearing things.**
34. **You aren't good enough for the ministry.**
35. **You have too many failures to continue in the ministry.**
36. **It is too big a price to remain in the ministry.**
37. **You have sinned. Nobody wants you around. Your ministry is finished.** This is to deceive you that there is no restoration.

38. You have no gifts from the Lord. You are nobody.
39. Jesus didn't defeat me (Satan) completely.
40. You don't need the five-fold ministry. You are beyond that.
41. Have a good time now and serve God later.
42. You won't be able to hold out (stand) in this spiritual warfare. This is spoken to produce fear. Remember, fear brings paralysis. And in it there is no strength to stand.
43. God is to blame for your circumstances (problems) because He hasn't taken action to change it. Don't you know He could have prevented it? The goal of this lie is to instill the root of resentment against God
44. You can do this wrong thing one more time. It won't hurt you. Come on, this will be your last. This lie promotes rebellion and disobedience.
45. You will not have any friends if you walk spiritually. In fact, at this very moment you are being fanatical.
46. You are always right. It's others who are wrong. This lie promotes and instills pride.
47. You are in a hopeless situation, so take your life. This lie is spoken to rob God of what He is to have in your life on this earth: "fruit."
48. The ministry will not accept you unless you cover up your flesh and pretend to be spiritual in their presence. This lie promotes hypocrisy, thereby destroying transparency, which brings healing and growth.

49. **Divorce your wife. You don't love her anymore. She is a heart-ache. After all, she doesn't love you or please you.**
50. **Divorce your husband. There's a better man out there than him. He doesn't love you anyway.** This lie and the above one promote division and death. It destroys God's divine intent of a marriage that exemplifies Christ in the earth.
51. **Children are nothing but a nuisance. Do not have any more.**
52. **If you discipline your children, they won't love you. In fact, they will turn on you. You really don't want to spend the time anyhow to do this; you have too many other things to do.** This lie also promotes rebellion and robs God of disciplined children. *"Even a child reveals himself by his acts, whether what he does is pure and right."* Proverbs 20:11 Berkeley Version.
53. **Do not bring children into this world because times are too hard to support them and the environment is too evil and difficult for them to live in. The enemy's purpose by this lie is to prevent kingdom children (godly seed) from being born. (This lie can find an entrance into our minds because of fear and selfishness.) Note: Psalms 127:3-5.**
54. **There is no way out of this temptation. You have always yielded to it, and you will yield again.**
55. **No one wants to hear what you have to say. You are not worth anything. No one cares about what you think.**
56. **Go ahead and compromise is acceptable because it eases the situation.** It is in this way that the enemy endeavors to entice us not to stand in what is absolute truth, or what is right. In this manner he appeals to some selfishness in us, or our desire for gain or personal acceptance. Because we desire

something so strongly, we can justify a wrong and therefore believe a lie that compromise is acceptable. Continual compromise reveals a flaw in character. The adversary gains the ground of compromise in some because he knows that in them there is a lack in standing for what is right. Beware of pleasing men and yourself. When you believe a lie of compromise, you have also lied to yourself. There is no lie in God. Neither does He compromise. Blessed is the man that is governed by the truth and therefore unmovable in the face of temptation to compromise.

57. **You will not reap what you sow. You will get away with it.**
58. **You are going to die in the midst of this circumstance.** The whole point of this statement is to bring you to fear, just like Nehemiah's adversaries tried with him. Neh. 6:5-19.
59. **God won't heal you. You will die.**
60. **Your marriage is over and never will be what it should be.**
61. **You are still guilty of all the sins of the past. If you have asked for forgiveness that is a lie**
62. **Prayer is a struggle. Just quit. You don't feel his presence any more.**
63. **The baptism in holy Spirit was only for the early church. You don't need that now.**
64. **The gifts of the Spirit have been revoked. Only fanatical people think they exercise them.**
65. **Don't think about the gift of tongues. That is of the devil. Note he doesn't mind being blamed for this one.**

- 66. You will never get free from drug and alcohol addiction.** Here Satan presents a hopeless situation and by presenting a lie that these chains of bondage cannot be broken.
- 67. You will have the same traits, behavior, sins, problems and sicknesses that your family line has.** You don't have to take this lie on board. It will cause worry, stress and open you up to these things.
- 68. You don't have obey your parents all the time, you are old enough to make up your own mind.** The truth is, to obey your parents is to obey the Lord. To love the Lord is to obey your parents.
- 69. Your temptation means you are an evil person.** Know that temptation is not a sin, only yielding to it is.

The adversary, with lies and with evil pressure, works upon our emotions and desires us not to pray or read God's Word or overcome. He works to weaken our will, because a weakened man will soon change his decision. Now you understand the strategy of lying bombardments. You have seen your adversary's persistence; God desires you to be as persistent in standing against him.

THE GRAND COVER-UP

Any success Satan has is in a lie; this is his power. Therefore, **deception** and **intimidation** is his trade. Remember, he lies about everything and everyone. As he has lied about God and His Son, know that he has a master lie about himself. He is a messenger of light, meaning false understanding. 2 Cor. 11:14. **Your adversary must lie about what has already happened to him**. He puts all effort in presenting himself as not defeated. He doesn't in anyway desire that the church realize that Christ has already won; that the victory is complete. The ancient lie is that the victory is yet to be completed. He is struggling exceedingly to cover up his past defeat, and presents a lying image that he is a victor. Of a certainty, he will fight the ministry who declares it.

Many are awaiting Satan's complete defeat. I am not. What Jesus did to him is finished from the standpoint of victory. See Col. 2:15. To believe that and walk in it is for a church to live in the truth, and in the victory Christ won. Therefore Christ's past victory is a present victory and we must receive a victory to have a victory.

Not only is Satan saying that his own defeat is not complete, he is telling others with lying power that he no longer exists. What a great cover-up in which to hide and maintain deception. He told Eve she would not die if she ate of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Genesis 3:4-5. Consider his deception and motive here; he didn't tell her there was no God. Why? She had often been walking with Him in the cool of the day with her husband.

In this case Satan would have gained no ground in telling her there was no God. Why? It is because God was too real to her. Therefore, he said "I will seek to destroy the holy fruit in her, and work my fruit in her." How? By lying to her that she will grow more like God if she disregards His command. So the adversary told Eve she would not die if she partook of the tree, but look at the graveyards over the world; and every death from then to now expose that lie. **What a plan and what a lie, and he still fosters it**. Look at religion and you shall see and understand. Impure

religion says this is the way, walk ye in it. Sad, but true, many do not know that their religion is a way of disobedience, because the teachings of it are a lie from the adversary.

God spoke these following words in 1990: *This is not the day of the enemy's complete defeat; for this was accomplished long ago; but it is the day of the MANIFESTATION of the reality of that defeat and the totality of it in the earthly realm. The Lord said, He shall make his defeat known and publish it throughout every nation and kingdom. It shall be forever known here as it has been known in the spirit realm for ages. Furthermore, the Lord has said that He is bringing forth a people with whom Satan will no longer be able to lie to or bargain with. They will not exchange the reality of his defeat for the reality of their victory. When we believe his lie we bear witness that his defeat is false, and that Christ's victory is a lie.*

The Greatest lie on this earth is concerning God's beloved Son Jesus. But it shall be known for what it is: a lie

JESUS' VICTORY IS COMPLETE IN THE PAST

***H**e that committeth sin is of the devil, for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was MANIFESTED, that he might destroy the works of the devil. I John 3:8.*

The purpose of the manifestation or appearing of Jesus was to destroy what Satan had established in man; which was all his works. The Greek word for destroy is Lou, and it means to loosen, to dissolve. Do you realize that the nature of Satan was established in man when Adam disobeyed? In Adam all were constituted sinners; having in themselves a sin nature. This nature would always be after self-gratification; only the appearing of Jesus would redeem us to be self-giving. ***“Behold the lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.”*** John 1:29. (“Taketh” here means on Himself, to bear it away). He shed His blood (life) for the forgiveness of sins. **Sins** are the deeds, but **sin** is the root. Our salvation does not only consist of being forgiven of sins, the things we have done; it consists also of dissolving and loosening us from the root, which produces the sins. **This root is sin in our flesh or the spirit of iniquity.** Jesus came to deliver us from it; for its presence in us is after the working of Satan. What must be perceived and believed is that the victory of Jesus in the PAST is COMPLETE for our deliverance today.

The Holy Spirit says in the book of Hebrews that what Jesus did to secure our full redemption is not to be repeated. He will not suffer again for our salvation; it has been done once for all. Hebrews 9:12, 14, 24-28; 10:5-14. **He could not have loosened or dissolved Satan’s work in us if His victory was not a total one.** I know of no place in the Word of God that speaks of

the progressive victory of Jesus; a little at the beginning, and throughout the centuries a little more until it is done. No! Emphatically No! **The cross and resurrection is a climax, a finality.** If you are a victor, you have won, not shall win. In Philippians 2:6 - 11 it says that Jesus is Lord, and Satan knows this. Jesus has the authority, not Satan. Jesus, as Lord, has the keys of hell (grave) and death. Revelation 1:18. See Hebrews 2:14.

Therefore He is absolute victor, Lord of Lords and King of Kings. He has the absolute redeeming authority and right to come into our lives and deliver us. Praise the Lord! This is based then, upon the reality that, *“Jesus having spoiled principalities and powers, He made a shew of them openly; triumphing over them in it.” Colossians 2:15.* After Jesus totally defeated Satan, Father God gave to Him **all authority** in heaven and earth. Matthew 28:18. Therefore Jesus works now from His victory, to complete His work of progressively loosening and dissolving Satan’s works (which is the flesh or sin nature) in us. **He is not seeking a victory for Himself, that is finished and settled, but He does seek that we will have His victory produced in us. In other words, we must receive His victory that we may have a victory.** We understand that Jesus is yet to put all His enemies under His feet and the last is death. He has authority to do this in the time appointed, out of the power of His past victory. I Corinthians 15:20-28.

God’s ways are thus: this completed work of Christ in a total victory over Satan and flesh is at our disposal, but only upon the law or principal of faith. If we do not by faith receive it, it appears that Satan is not defeated. Our unbelief then gives a lying witness that our adversary has not been conquered.

JESUS'S PAST VICTORY NOT ISOLATED FROM THE PRESENT

How awesome it is that in the spiritual realm we are raised up together and made to sit in heavenly places in Christ Jesus. Ephesians 2:6. While that is a reality, the other reality is that we are right in the midst of spiritual warfare with the adversary. As this age grows to a close, the battles are more intense and aggressive. To view these end-time battles from the position of true knowledge and faith is to be properly armed in the fight. To endure in the battle can only be done in the truth that the battle is already won by Jesus. His victory is a PRESENT SUBSTANCE in the spiritual realm; always waiting to manifest in the present, in every battle. No matter what the circumstances, the temptation, or the condition of things Jesus' past victory is ever present by faith. God is able to make all grace (abound towards you) that you may appropriate His victory in all things. All evil principalities and powers know this past completed victory of Jesus, which is ever present, and they realize it more than the church does today. My prayer is that this book by the Spirit may bring many to this awareness.

We desire victory, but to have victory, we have tried religion, methods and formulas against Satan and the flesh. O! That our eyes would be open to see that the victory is in Holiness, which is the very thing that Satan and flesh opposes and fights the most. Jesus' holiness secured the victory for us, not for Himself; only a holy and pure lamb could have achieved our freedom. I wish to repeat; only a holy church will do what Jesus did. A holy church is the Father's objective in the earth; to demonstrate His Son's victory by living victoriously over flesh and Satan in the victory of Jesus. Many are trying to do spiritual warfare in these days without holiness. This is utter foolishness.

Oh, my people, live holy and you will see the victory of Jesus over your adversary now. Surely as I am God it shall manifest in your faith and obedience. See to it that

you receive it! The Lord is telling us **we are to use the victory of Jesus** in the fight with the adversary.

There is no aspect of the redemptive work of Jesus in the past that is **isolated** from the present or future. Therefore His righteous act of love and obedience in laying His life down to save us is powerful in the present. All present victory over the evil one and the sin nature in our members is **first based upon what Jesus was and is (pure Son of God). Second, it is based upon what He has done, not upon what He will do.** Why? Because what He continues to do is rooted in what He has done in His complete defeat of Satan. The past is an achievement of triumph. Therefore the victory of today and tomorrow is based upon the foundational work of yesterday past. It is finished! John 19:30.

Christ will have a perfected people; but He is still at work, to bring the completed victory to our lives. It must become clear to you that you can have victory over sin and the evil one in the battle because Jesus already conquered. According to the Word of God, we are not in the present **isolated** from the past death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Our Father has done a unique thing. He has actually placed us in a spiritual reality that happened nearly 2,000 years ago. He has done this by divine wisdom and power, in an unparalleled way. What did He do? He positioned us into His Son's actual **death** on the cross when we believed His Word. This means when He died, we died! This did not remove Satan or our sin nature; it broke their power. Now we do not have to serve them anymore. Praise God!

Furthermore, Father placed us in the realm of the spirit; into His Son's **resurrection**. Therefore we are spiritually raised out of our deadness in sin. The bodily resurrection is yet to follow. See Romans 6; Colossians 3:1. Positionally then we were placed into Christ's victory, therefore, if we choose to believe it, we are **dead to defeat**.

Who, saith the Lord, in spiritual union with my Son has known and believed this? I call my church to

transparency; have you not thought this beyond what could be, have you believed a lie? You know not the power of His victory; yea, that it is here today. Yea, I will find one, I will find some who will lay hold to it, and show the disbeliever that it is so; O! That it is so. You have believed your adversary's word concerning sin, not mine, yea, you have more faith in sin (its power) than me.

Satan, sin in our members and evil spirits are not fighting the establishment of our union with Christ as children of God. Why? Because we have been placed in union with Him in His death and resurrection; as a past act of Father God. They diligently oppose what is ordained to come out of that union. With all lying power, cunning temptations, and evil pressure of all sorts, they seek to prevent the sure realities of holiness and righteousness, which are to be experienced in this POSITION. Nothing happens in this position **automatically**; if it did, there would be no need of overcoming. See Revelation 3:5,12,21; 15:2.

Do my people really know? Yea, who has opened their eyes by anointed preaching to see what their death in my Son means? Open your hearts and learn: it means the end of sin ruling my people! Yea, I broke sin's power over them, and gave them a way to live victorious over it. I, in love, gave my Son to die; but do you see that I decreed more than His death? I appointed your death to sin in Him.

Father desires us to realize **our union with Christ is a union into complete victory**. We have been positioned into it, but this does not mean we are yet Christ-like in divine nature. In this position we are to be formed into His exact image. Therefore, the exhortation is to go on unto perfection (maturity). Hebrews 6:1. Scripture declares in Romans 6:1-2 that we are dead to sin, meaning a separation has taken place and its

power is broken. Before our union with Jesus in His death, sin and Satan had dominion and ruled over us. In this realm they kept us in bondage and death, with no choice but to serve sin.

Once again I repeat, the realities that God ordained for us to experience in our union with Christ are not automatic. They can only be known in our submission to the reign of Grace (God's provision and ability) by faith and obedience. Romans 6:14; I John 5:1-5. **The Word of God is clear, we are dead to sin; but sin is not dead; therefore the fight is on.** The fight is from a NEW POSITION and not from our old position as a helpless slave to sin. We are free men under Jesus, our new King. In Christ, we are now free to fight, free to stand, that the Spirit may conform us to His image that His life might manifest in this mortal body. You mean in this weak body under these conditions on this earth? Yes! Romans 8:29; II Corinthians 4:10-11. There will be a people in these end-time days that will know end-time grace, and come into what God has promised. I Peter 1:5, 13. We are in the season of overcoming until the Lord takes the liar and the tempter away forever.

Do you wonder why the adversary is still permitted here after his defeat? We must see that the Lord has a principle or rule of action for imparting of His nature in our union with Christ. He does not impart His likeness apart from testing, obedience and faith. Victory is given in the face of the adversary, for we must be proven in the fight. Therefore, don't you see that Satan is only an instrument in the Father's hand? If you will not allow your faith to be misdirected to a lie, then you may have what God offers: the fruit of the Spirit. Do you realize now how responsible you are with your faith? The Lord has permitted the adversary to war against us because we must be tested, and he desires us to pass the test by grace received. In this He receives the glory. ***"Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting. And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not."** Galatians 6:7-9.*

Faith in God's truth is not mere assent; it is commitment, which comes out of a right heart, to walk it in the face of every opposition. I have no right to say I believe unless I am willing to live my life in the Spirit of truth, and prove in the earth Jesus' victory is real. Whatever path you must walk, as a believer you must endure and not allow the adversary to change your mind. It is in this arena of conflict we become like Jesus. You may think this is redundant; but faith and obedience alone can prove truth, as truth in the earth. True, it has been said often in this writing, but children of God, it is imperative to live every moment and every hour of the day in faith and obedience. That's how serious it is. **We can speak of being a witness but before you can become a witness to truth, God must deal with your doubt, unbelief, rebellion and disobedience.**

The past victory of Jesus is spiritual and is laid up in the invisible realm. It is a spiritual substance for all the days of your life in this body, and for the resurrection of your body, which is the complete manifestation of it. The Father will only impart it to a certain kind of people in the earth. How does He impart it and how does it manifest? Remember the principle of impartation. Consider Jesus' words to Peter when Satan asked to obtain him for sifting. Luke 22:31-32. Jesus in this case did not say no to Satan; He told Peter that He had interceded for his faith not to fail. This reveals that Peter had to flow in God's way to have a victory in order not to be devoured by the adversary. Did Peter utterly fail? No! What secured him? FAITH! Jesus was telling Peter that God had a way of imparting victory. It is of interest to note the Greek word for fail here is ek-lepio. It means to leave off or out; to relinquish or desert; thus failing in the use of faith. We must see that there is no neutral ground. If I relinquish faith in the truth, then I place my faith in a lie.

Consider the content of Christ's prayer for Peter. The Lord's Prayer was that he would remain responsible with faith while contending with his flesh and Satan. He must, at all times, exercise it and not relinquish it. So the appearing of the adversary is an occasion to be responsible in faith and with it quench all the fiery darts (lies and suggestions) of the evil one.

Therefore take the shield of faith (your belief in the truth) and quench his lies. See Ephesians 6:16. It should be clear to you that the victory of Jesus will only be imparted to those who will not relinquish faith in the battle. Yes! To those alone who will trust and obey. So Peter went through a trial of faith, not to see if he had faith, but to determine if he would use it. See I Peter 1:7; James 1:12. Therefore, Satan and sin are permitted to war so that you may experience the reality of that victory in the battle and bring GLORY TO THE SON OF GOD. What is the Spirit saying? “Satan is defeated and the sin nature is defeated.” How many times has this been declared in this writing? Listen to what is true and cannot be altered.

We must come back to our position in Christ, especially the aspect of the resurrection. We are spiritually raised, but not out of the battle. ***“If, then, you have been raised with Christ, seek the things which are above, where Christ is seated at God’s right hand. Apply your mind to things above, not to things on earth; (why?) for you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.....Therefore put to death whatever in your nature belongs to the earth.:” Colossians 3:1-3,5, Berkeley Version.*** We were raised to seek the nature of Christ (things above) but in the very face of the enemy. Psalms 23:5. ***“Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of my adversaries.” Berkeley Version.*** God in this hour will know who is determined, committed and desiring of Holiness. He allows the adversary to oppose to see who will pay the price to have the glory.



Children of God, **we must do all that is required** in order to stand in the battle. Ephesians 6:13. We must be persuaded of the truth which declares all is complete, and that all the provision is at our disposal to overcome. II Peter 1:3-4. Paul said through the Spirit, ***“But in all this, we are more than conquerors through Him (Jesus) who loved us.” Romans 8:37. Berkeley Version.*** Paul did not say that we would barely win. He used a compound word in the Greek to express the awesome greatness of that victory which still exists as a present result. The word is

hupernikao, which the King James renders as MORE THAN. Hupernikao means a victory that is over and above, beyond measure or transcending; a super abounding victory. Our standing must begin with this assured knowledge and faith. **We do not wait to see if we will have victory and then praise God. We praise God at the beginning of the battle, knowing we cannot lose in the realm of faith and obedience.** We are called by the Spirit of holiness to occupy and possess, not to retreat or give up. You may know the truth is real, and not desire it. If you disbelieve the truth you will discredit it. Nevertheless, every man, every adversary shall give an account for the way they have responded to the truth.

Did I not tell you this in the beginning when I first spoke to you, saith the Lord. Yea, your faith and obedience will set the reality before your eyes, and you will praise me with might and power and I will hear from heaven and manifest myself unto you. For in this I am well pleased that my people believe me. (Hebrews 11:6) All that My Son has achieved will manifest, saith God, and no man will teach his neighbor for all men shall know me. Yea, even my glory shall cover the earth as the waters cover the sea. Yea, in the seasons ahead I will take away the defeated one for I will have no more use for him. But I say unto you, do not underestimate him. Be sober and watchful. Faith is your victory. (1 John 5:4). Faith

exercised means you have received. If you will believe, yea saith the Lord, then I will cause you to triumph in My Son. (11 Corinthians 2:14). The effects of such faith will set all creation free, saith the Lord. (Romans 8:19-23).

So I am dealing with you in this hour to receive the victory. Oh! Do you have ears to hear? I have those on the scene even now, saith the Lord, who by means of strong spiritual arms will put to flight the enemy and declare My Son's glory. Go not by what you see, but by what I say. For what I say is greater than what you see in the world at this hour. Arise and be purposed of heart to flow with me in prayer and intercession. Yea, to flow with me in the fulfillment of my purposes. This is a call to faith, saith God. For those who obey this call, they shall witness the reality. Be of good courage, you shall know the actual and the true defeat of your adversaries. My true gospel is re-appearing to declare the real and true Word in the land. Oh! How I have longed for you to know this in your heart and not to be afraid. Remember, the devils tremble, as they believe in what is so. (James 2:19). They know the power of one drop of My Son's blood, and so shall you my sons, so shall you. Oh! Great is the day, the perfect day that I have fixed for thee. Hold fast till I come. Oh, how I love you greatly and desire to give you all things and so I will, to the heart full of faith. Oh! Run the race that is set before you, that when I appear I may fix you forever in holiness and righteousness. Do not be weary in well doing, my sons. Lay hold and do not allow the adversary to intimidate you for he shall surely try.

Look to the victory of Jesus Christ, Son of the Living God, for it is the very root of our faith out of which is the reality and reason of our present victory.

- A prophetic word given in 1990.

Every man shall give an account of the way he responded to the truth. O! For a people who will live in the reality of their victory, a people reckoning themselves dead to defeat. Yea, a people who know and love the joy of standing and rejoice in it, giving no ground; forcing the enemy to bow his knees to confess openly his awful defeat at the hand of the Lord. Yet precious ones, I would not have you ignorant, for if you think for a moment that he will manifest the reality of the completeness of his defeat willingly, then you do not know your enemy at all. Remember I have told you there is no truth in him. When he bows his knees confessing only his hopeless condition, it will be because you have stood knowing (with a believing heart and obedient action) confessing only your total victory. For he will confess no more or no less than you (in your standing) require of him. Prayerfully read over and over Ephesians 6:10-18, Proverbs 30:8.

Remember, truth is only effective when it is believed. Since truth directs our faith, true direction is imperative. We do not control what we believe, what we believe controls us.
